

2011-2012 Learn-to-Skate

The Learn-to-Skate program is designed to serve the needs of recreational and competitive skaters ages 3 and up. We offer group classes that have been tailored to each skating skill and age level in order to provide the best quality of instruction. This program offers beginning and intermediate skating skills that will allow skaters to progress to more advanced figure skating and hockey.

Skaters will have a 30 minute group lesson as well as 30 minutes of free skating time to practice their skills. Private lessons will be available during each half hour free skate for skaters who are interested.

This season's Learn-to-Skate consists of 3 sessions, 8 or 7 weeks each that will be held on Sundays between 12:30 and 2:30 at the Albany Academy Field House ice rink located at 117 Hackett Blvd in Albany. The cost of the 8 week session is \$135.00, or \$155.00 for Finer Edge skaters, and the 7 week session is \$120.00, or 137.50 for Finer Edge skaters. Any skater registered for all 3 sessions by September 4 will receive a \$40.00 discount off total fee. Session packages include all Albany Figure Skating Club AND US Figure Skating dues.

All skaters must be registered with the Learn-to-Skate program, and have completed the 'Waiver of Liability' in order to skate on the Learn-to-Skate ice.

Registration for this session due January 1, 2012.

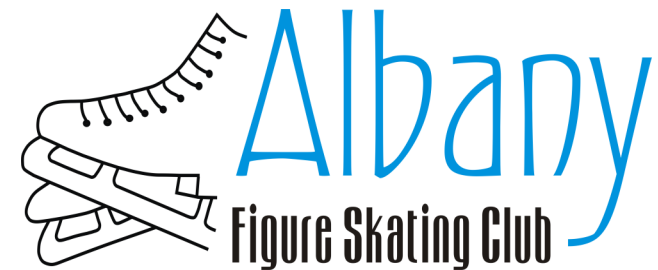

Group Classes offered by

Albany FSC Learn-to-Skate Program

Snowplow Sam: Designed for pre-school age skaters, ages 3-5. Skaters will have a 30 minute group lesson each week to learn skating basics where each class concentrates specifically on our youngest skaters and how they learn.

Basic Skills: Program for school-aged skaters (age 5 and up) that teaches the basics and advanced skating skills in 30 minute group lessons. Groups are divided by skating skill/level and age in order to provide skaters with best possible learning environment.

Finer Edge: Skaters at the level of USFS Basic 3 or ISI Beta or above are invited to join our Finer Edge program that concentrates on developing the more advanced skating skills. Group lessons are limited to 6 skaters per group to allow for more individualized attention for each skater. You will see a slight increase in price due to this smaller student-to-coach ratio.

Adult: This 30 minute group lesson will provide a curriculum centered around the basic and upper level skating skills of adult skaters. These groups are for older teens and adult skaters only.

Hockey: For those who want to learn how to skate like a hockey player! These 30 minute group lessons are focused on basic skating and hockey skills with no sticks or pucks.

Synchronized Skating: Skaters in the Finer Edge program can venture a try at Synchronized Skating. *Synchro* is focused on developing individual and team skating skills. A 30 minute lesson teaches skaters *Synchro* basics; how to perform together as a team using different holds and steps to create various formations on the ice. This program provides skaters with the unique opportunity to hone their own skating skills while enjoying all other aspects of a team sport.

*A 30 minute free-skate practice session will either precede or follow each group lesson (with the exception of Synchronized Skating).
